

Civic Plaza Regulations

- 1) Cars, trucks and machinery for display: must be clean, have a "locking-type" gas cap, and tanks must not be full to allow for normal expansion. Protective sheets of plastic must be placed underneath the vehicle or machinery.
- 2) Compressed air & propane tanks must be secured and/or placed in a stand of sufficient size and weight to prevent tipping.
- 3) Exhibitors using electrical, mechanical, hydraulic, or flame producing elements and displays requiring flammable fuel shall have a ABC dry chemical extinguisher at all times (5 lb. minimum).
- 4) All props and decorations must fall within the specifications of the current BC Fire Code. Open flamed candles are not permitted.
- 5) Maximum 20lb. propane container, subject to Provincial Gas Inspection is permitted.
- 6) The Exhibitor is responsible for obtaining all licenses and/or permits applicable to their event from the City of Prince George.
- 7) Exhibitors handling food/beverage must obtain a current Food Safe Certificate and meet the requirements of the Health Inspection Branch of BC.
- 8) Storage facilities are not available on site. Advance shipments of large materials cannot be accepted.
- 9) Removal of bricks from the Plaza Area is prohibited.
- 10) The use of tacks, staples, nails, etc... on the Civic Plaza property is not permitted.
